

# Transformation Closet Coordinator Sexual Health Nova Scotia

Contract Term: Tentatively April 2025 - September 31, 2025 at 25-35 hours a week and October 1, 2025 - March 31, 2026 at 20-25 hours a week with possibility of renewal/expansion pending funding (some flexibility around hours built into the role)

Rate of Pay: \$25/hr

Location: Remote, with some travel around Nova Scotia, possibility of working from Halifax Sexual Health Centre

#### About Sexual Health Nova Scotia:

Sexual Health Nova Scotia (SHNS) represents the provincial network of community-based sexual health centres. We work together to champion positive sexual health throughout the lifespan for all Nova Scotians through the following core activities: Advocacy; Education; Navigation; Partnership.

## **About the SHNS Transformation Closet:**

The Transformation Closet is an initiative that began at the South Shore Sexual Health Centre and has expanded provincially through SHNS. This program offers free gender-affirming gear to trans, non-binary, and gender non-conforming folks across Nova Scotia. The gear we offer includes gaffs, Breast Forms, stand-to-pees, packers, binders, and TransTape. Gear can be picked up at any of our partner locations or, in the case where someone cannot access a center, items can be mailed out. We hope to continue this program and expand it to include wider-reaching promotions, the creation of resources, the development and delivery of virtual events or workshops, and a stronger presence at in-person events. The SHNS Transformation Closet Coordinator will be responsible for all day-to-day operations of The Closet with the support of the SHNS Executive Director.

# **Key Responsibilities of this Role:**

- Researching and ordering low-cost gender-affirming gear in an inclusive range of sizes and colors, maintaining relationships with stockists
- Keeping clear and organized order and inventory records
- Communicating with folks ordering gear and fulfilling orders
- Coordinating delivery, or delivering, gear to our partner pick-up locations
- Expanding our partner pick-up locations in unserved areas of the province



- Promoting the Transformation Closet on social media and other platforms, including the creation of social media graphics and short videos
- Recording, evaluating, and reporting program progress and output
- Developing virtual and print information and safety resources for gender-affirming gear
- Developing and delivering virtual and in-person workshops on gender-affirming gear
- Researching funding opportunities, administering small fundraisers, and writing grant applications to continue and expand the program
- Attending meetings related to gender-affirming gear and support organizational advocacy efforts related to gender-affirming care
- Being a part of the vision and planning for the direction of the program
- Submitting a short monthly report the the SHNS Board of Directors

- has strong skills writing in English, preference will be given to folks who are also able to speak and write in French and/or Indigenous languages
- has a driver's license and access to a vehicle (mileage will be compensated)
- with a demonstrated passion for community care, trans and nonbinary advocacy, gender, sexual health, and 2SLGBTQIA+ issues
- with an anti-oppressive, anti-racist, disability justice, de-colonial, and trauma-informed lens on all work that they do
